ASK YOURSELF:

Is this simply an inconvenience? Is it temporary? Can I put up with it and be okay?

Can I handle this on my own? Is this something I could try to talk this out with the person?

Is there a friend, neighbor, or someone I could call to help?

Can I use mediation to talk through this or can I call an emergency response hotline?

MEDIATION

Provides mediation for arguments between neighbors, community disputes, landlord/tenant disputes, marriage and divorce disputes, and more. Can also support community building activities and restorative justice. Screens for safety of all participants.

SEXUAL ASSAULT & DOMESTIC VIOLENCE

24-hour helpline. Will perform medical forensic examination for survivors of sexual assault. This includes a rape kit that will be held for up to a year (should be performed within 5 days of assault) while victim/survivor decides whether to file a police report. Can provide advocacy and short-term counseling as well as other sexual assault services. Helps domestic violence victims and survivors with safety plans, short-term counseling, and shelter. Mandated reporter for child abuse and elder abuse.

Available 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. Call for individuals experiencing a mental health crisis or needing a wellness check. If situation is deemed safe, crisis team may appear without police. If safety is an issue, team may call police.

Has a strict policy of confidentiality for youth who access their services. Will only comply with police for warrant or parole officer order. Will only call police as last resort.
